the new "kitchen" under the tarp. Children sang welcome songs and the parents expressed gratitude.

We were treated to a practice session led by Calvary's worship leader, Eubert who in addition to serving as principle at a school for 600 in the mountains volunteers to teach the children from the after school program to play wind instruments. We hope they will lead the procession through the streets of Jacmel at next summer's revival.



A trip would not be complete without visiting Pastor Roger at the Beaudoin church where we found him teaching and leading the singing before providing a meal to the children.

One of the first members of Calvary church, Rosalin continues to serve in many ministries including leading teaching and prayer before a children's meal in Calvary.





Those of you who have traveled with us in the last two years got to know Germaine, Kerline and Rony. They have been faithful interpreters for the deworming, and VBS trips. They lead much of the after school programs and teach Sunday school. They have graduated from secondary school and been accepted to university programs. Financial help is need for them to attend. Unlike the U.S. a student can
